



JUNIOR PROGRAM

“Helping Young Golfers Develop Their Games, Building Life-Changing Habits And Skills,
While Maximizing Enjoyment Of The Game”

Program Options

Any youth 16 years of age or under is eligible to enter our junior program. All juniors have full playing privileges with no restrictions as to when they are able to play regardless of membership status. There are three options to choose from:

Full Membership

Includes unlimited golf, free junior golf clinics in the spring, summer fun tournaments green fee, junior member rate discount on driving range pass, annual club championship in the fall. The cost of the junior membership is \$240.⁰⁰.

Junior Restricted Pass

Includes reduced green fees to low restricted rate, access to summer fun tournaments, junior member rate discount on driving range pass. The cost of the Junior Restricted 30-Game Punch Pass is \$290.⁰⁰.

Pay-As-You Go

Anyone under the age of 16 will receive reduced green fees, access to summer fun tournaments, reduced rate on driving range pass, and discount on individual lessons with CPGA professional. Regular cost of junior green fees is \$13.⁰⁰ for 9-holes and \$22.⁰⁰ for 18-holes.

Junior Clinics

These lessons are 1 hour per day for 4 days (held in April and July/August), and we recommend that all first year juniors attend these lessons. These lessons will also be available to non-members and children on the waitlist at a cost of \$40.⁰⁰. For junior members the classes are included in their membership cost (April classes only).

Waitlist

The Hillview Golf Junior Program has at any given time a waiting list of approximately 50 names of kids wanting to get into the program. This translates to a 1 year waitlist. Depending on the year, we can accept anywhere from 70-100 juniors for the program, whereby the kids are taken on a first come first serve basis and there is no charge to put a juniors name on the waitlist.

Junior Restricted 30-Game Punch Pass

For children on the waitlist there is a pass available called a *Junior Restricted Pass*. This is a 30-game punch card that sells for \$290.⁰⁰, working out to \$9.⁶⁷ for 9 holes, and provides a total savings of \$100.⁰⁰. The only limitation is that the person named on the card is the only one who can use it and it is non-transferable. The only exception is that juniors in the same family household may have their name on one card, allowing siblings to share a card.

Course Access

For all juniors, members and non-members alike, there are no restrictions for playing. Hillview Golf operates on a first come first serviced basis for everyone and we do not book tee times. The only time the first tee is closed is when we have tournaments, in which case we will try to get players off the back-nine. If anyone shows up as a single or with a friend, they can expect to be paired up with other golfers. It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that **ALL JUNIORS BE COURTEOUS** and **OBSERVE PROPER ETIQUETTE**. Failure to do so will result in suspension of playing privileges. The greatest help can come from parents and/or adults who can play with the children and help teach them the fundamentals of etiquette and fair play.

Summer Tournaments

During the summer holidays (July & August) we will run some fun tournaments for the juniors. These will run on Tuesday afternoons starting at 12:00 noon for 8 consecutive weeks. The entry fee is usually around \$2.⁰⁰ per player (plus green fee if non-member), and there will be prizes presented after the round. All tournaments are 18-holes with a possible 9-hole segment and all juniors are eligible to play.

Range Membership

\$145.⁰⁰ unlimited pass for junior members, \$290.⁰⁰ two-buckets-per-day for junior non-members.

City Junior And Club Championship

Annual 16 and under tournament open to all juniors in the city of Vernon. Held the first pro-d day off at the beginning of the school year in September. Hillview junior club championship also decided at this event. Entry fee for members is a reduced rate.
